ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
MIDLAND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION  
Corporations Section

We, the undersigned natural persons, at least two (2) of whom are citizens of the State of Texas, and at least two of whom are of the age of eighteen (18) years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act, do hereby adopt the following Article of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE ONE  
NAME

The name of the corporation is the MIDLAND MUNICIPAL POLICE OFFICER'S ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE TWO  
NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE THREE  
DURATION

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE FOUR  
PURPOSES

The purposes for which this non-profit corporation is organized are:

1. To better working conditions of the employees and officers of the Midland Police Department by bringing to the attention of the legislative bodies in the City, County and State, the importance of General Laws for the betterment of law enforcement and the general welfare of law enforcement officers and support staff employees.
2. To foster and encourage a higher degree of skill and efficiency among those who are now engaged in law enforcement and to assist those persons who are actively engaged in law enforcement in an organized body so that the profession and all of its branches may be standardized effectively and scientifically administered.

3. It is the intent of this organization to remain nonsectarian and a voluntary association composed of Midland Police Department employees, exclusively for the pursuit of duty. Of promoting social fellowship and economic well being and toward this end, to furnish a place where meetings can be held, of instilling in the membership the spirit of cooperation and the high regard of our calling, of asserting a wholesome influence on the education of the Citizens of Midland, especially with the purpose of inculcating respect for law and order, to cooperate with the Courts and Judges thereof, and with the branches of our government, City, County, State, and National, of incorporating among the membership a closer personal acquaintance, and for the gathering, receiving and dissemination of such information as may be helpful to our members in the pursuit of duties.

**ARTICLE FIVE  
INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT**

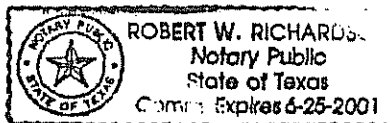
